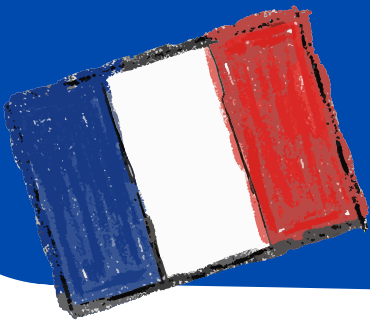
→ 📱 What is Brightwheel?

Brightwheel is an all-in-one app designed to help parents stay connected and informed throughout their child's day in our French After-School Program. It's a secure and easy-to-use platform that allows us to manage attendance, send updates, share photos, and communicate in real-time with families.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

FRENCH FOR FUN

Our French For Fun program is designed for young learners beginning at age 4. These playful, engaging sessions focus on oral language development through songs, games, movement, stories, and everyday conversation. Students are introduced to phonics, vocabulary, and simple sentence structures in a fun, low-pressure immersion environment.



READING CLINIC

One of the strongest successes of our current afterschool program, the Reading Clinic is specifically designed to support emerging readers in French.

Students work on:

- Phonics and sound recognition
- Syllables and decoding
- Reading fluency
- Reading comprehension
- Reading aloud with confidence

Instruction is individualized and highly interactive, helping students build foundational literacy skills in French.



PROGRAM DESCRIPTION



LA CLASSE / ACADEMIC SUPPORT

This class provides academic support and homework assistance in French for elementary students. Teachers help reinforce vocabulary, grammar, reading comprehension, writing skills, and classroom learning through personalized support and small-group instruction.

THEMATIC LEARNING WORKSHOP

This workshop uses project-based and thematic learning to deepen language acquisition through meaningful topics such as: Geography, Science, Nature, Arts, History, Culture. Activities include hands-on projects, group work, presentations, games, and collaborative exploration in French.



PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

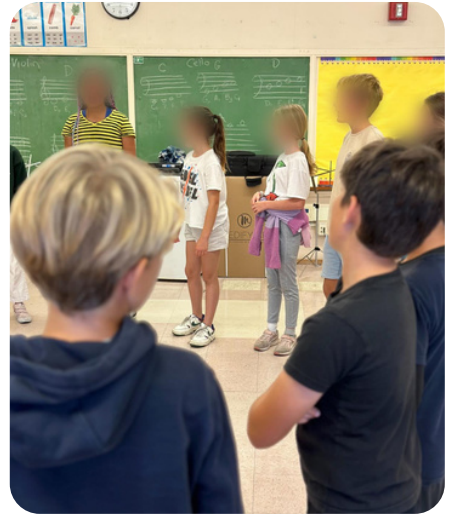
ART

Students explore a wide range of artistic materials and techniques inspired by artists, nature, storytelling, and their own creativity. Sessions emphasize hands-on learning, self-expression, and joyful experimentation in a French-speaking environment.



MUSIC & CHOIR

Through warm-ups, rhythm games, movement, singing, and musical exploration, students discover the joy of music and collective expression while developing listening skills, confidence, pronunciation, and teamwork.



SPORT / YOGA / MINDFULNESS

This enrichment class combines movement, wellness, cooperation, and emotional regulation through:

- Group games
- Stretching, Yoga
- Relaxation exercises, breathing techniques, mindfulness activities and discussions/tips about stress management.

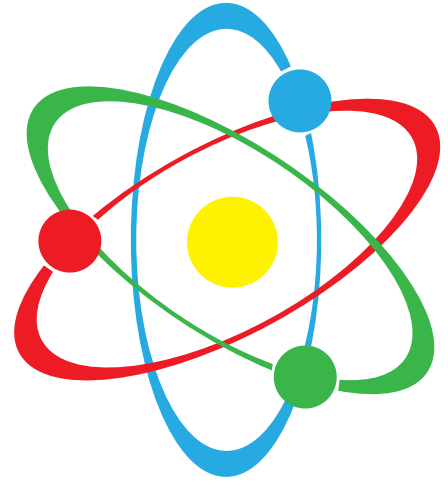
The goal is to support students' physical and emotional well-being after the school day.

STEM WORKSHOP

Our STEM classes introduce students to science, engineering, building challenges, problem-solving, and experimentation through age-appropriate hands-on activities conducted in French whenever possible.



DRAMA

Our Drama program encourages students to build confidence, creativity, and oral expression through improvisation, theater games, storytelling, character exploration, & short performances. Students work on:

- Public speaking
- Expressive language
- Collaboration
- Emotional expression
- Creativity and stage confidence



The class is conducted in a supportive and playful environment where students are encouraged to take creative risks and express themselves in French.

PRIVATE LESSONS

We provide personalized **French** (private & semi-private) lessons with a fully qualified native French teacher. You can start at any time and benefit from flexible scheduling and personalized curriculum for your child. Have a sibling/ friend /classmate join and learn together for more of a semi-private approach.

Private & semi-private lessons are available for all levels of proficiency. Lessons can take place at one of the LA French Academy campuses, at a private home, public library or online.

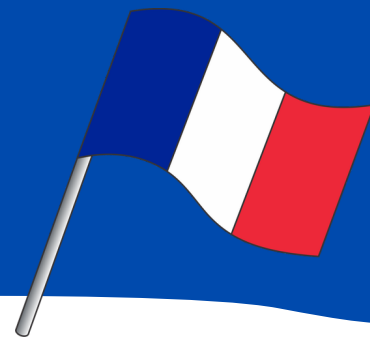

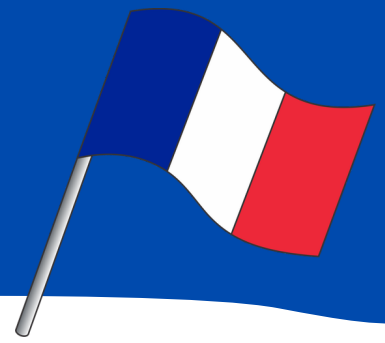
