Students develop their speaking, reading, writing, grammar, vocabulary, and comprehension skills through engaging and age-appropriate activities. To ensure the best learning experience, all students will be assessed by the teacher and placed in the group that best matches their current level and needs. Classes are offered on Monday, Wednesday, or Friday, depending on placement. If the assigned group schedule is not compatible with a family's availability, private or semi-private instruction may be offered online or in person, subject to availability.

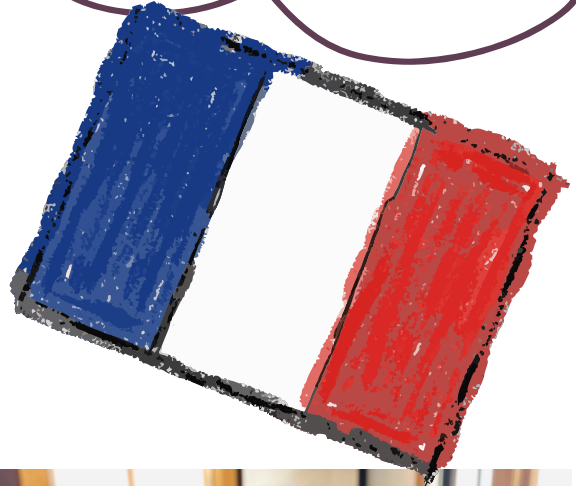

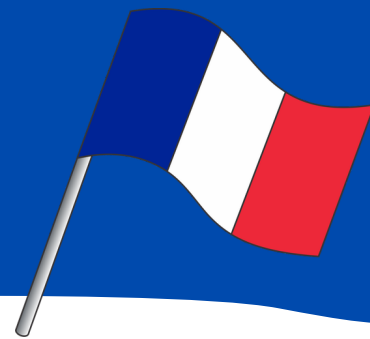

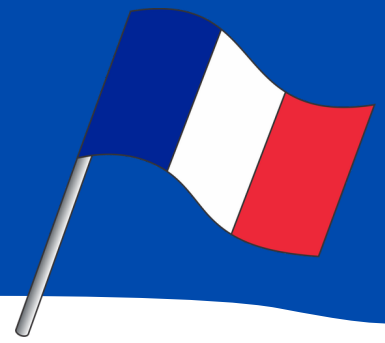
